

Squiggly Brushes

Simple, easy and unique painting tool



Playing is Learning!

Materials:

- Large rubber bands of varying widths
- Scissors
- Toilet paper or paper towel rolls
- Colored tape
- BioColor® Paint in squeeze bottles (3-4 colors)
- Paper

Procedure:

1. Cut tape an inch longer than the rim of the roll and place sticky side up on the table.
2. Cut rubber bands once to make long strings.
3. Place one end of the rubber band along the tape to create the bristles of the brush.
4. Repeat leaving finger's width of space between each rubber band.
5. Once all rubber bands are in place stick piece of tape along the bottom rim of the roll, forming a paintbrush or Squiggly Brush
6. Drizzle BioColor® Paint onto piece of paper.
7. Shake and bounce Squiggly Brush in paint.
8. Watch as an abstract "Pollock-esque" piece of art appears.
